- The list of poll workers is returned to our office and those selected by the Inspector will be reviewed by the Appointing Board, consisting of the probate judge, sheriff and circuit court clerk for Limestone County. When the workers list is approved, a letter will be mailed notifying them of their appointment to serve.
